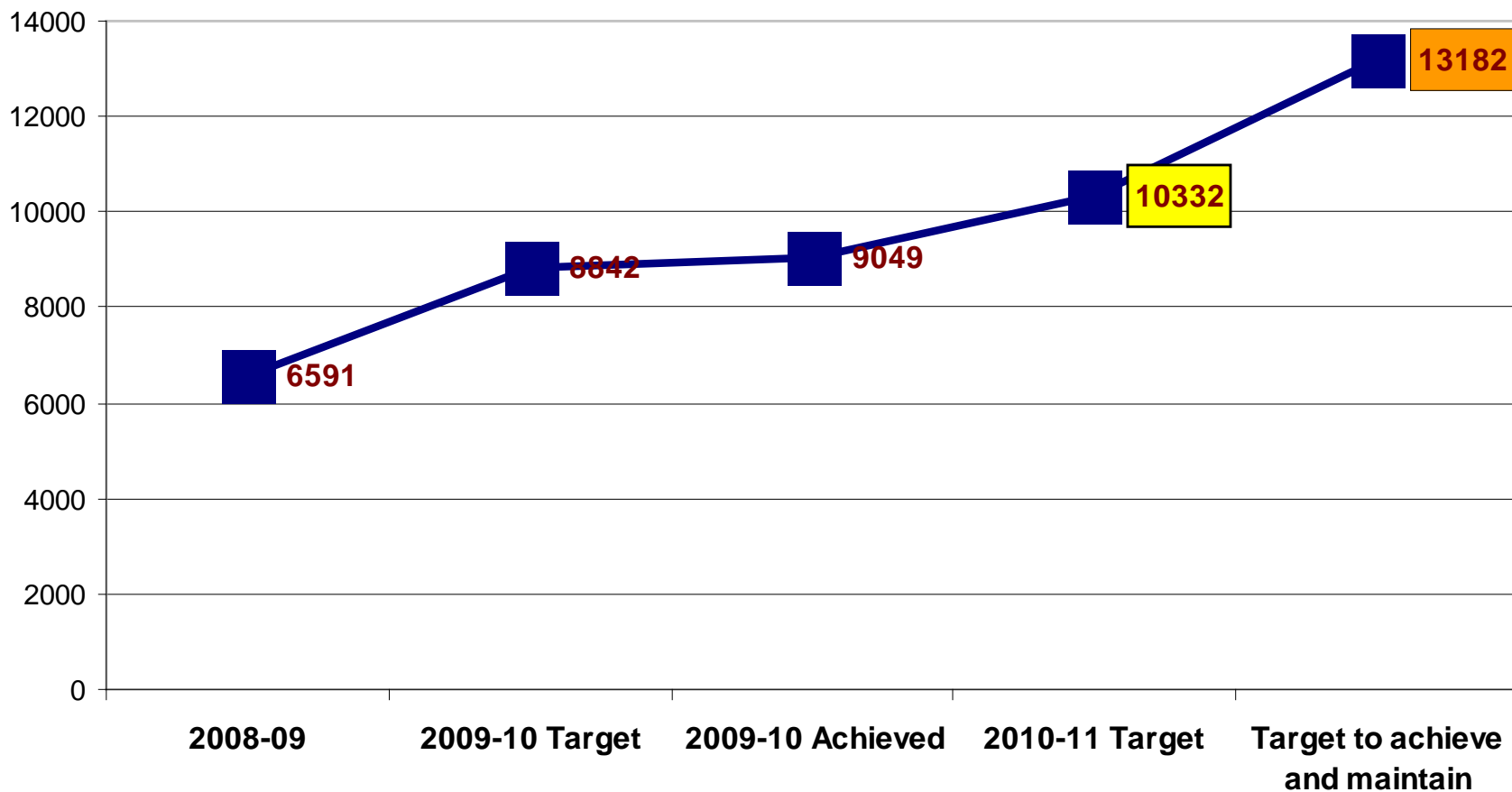



- To reduce the time taken to achieve NHS permission through the Coordinated System for gaining NHS Permission (CSP) in line with national expectations

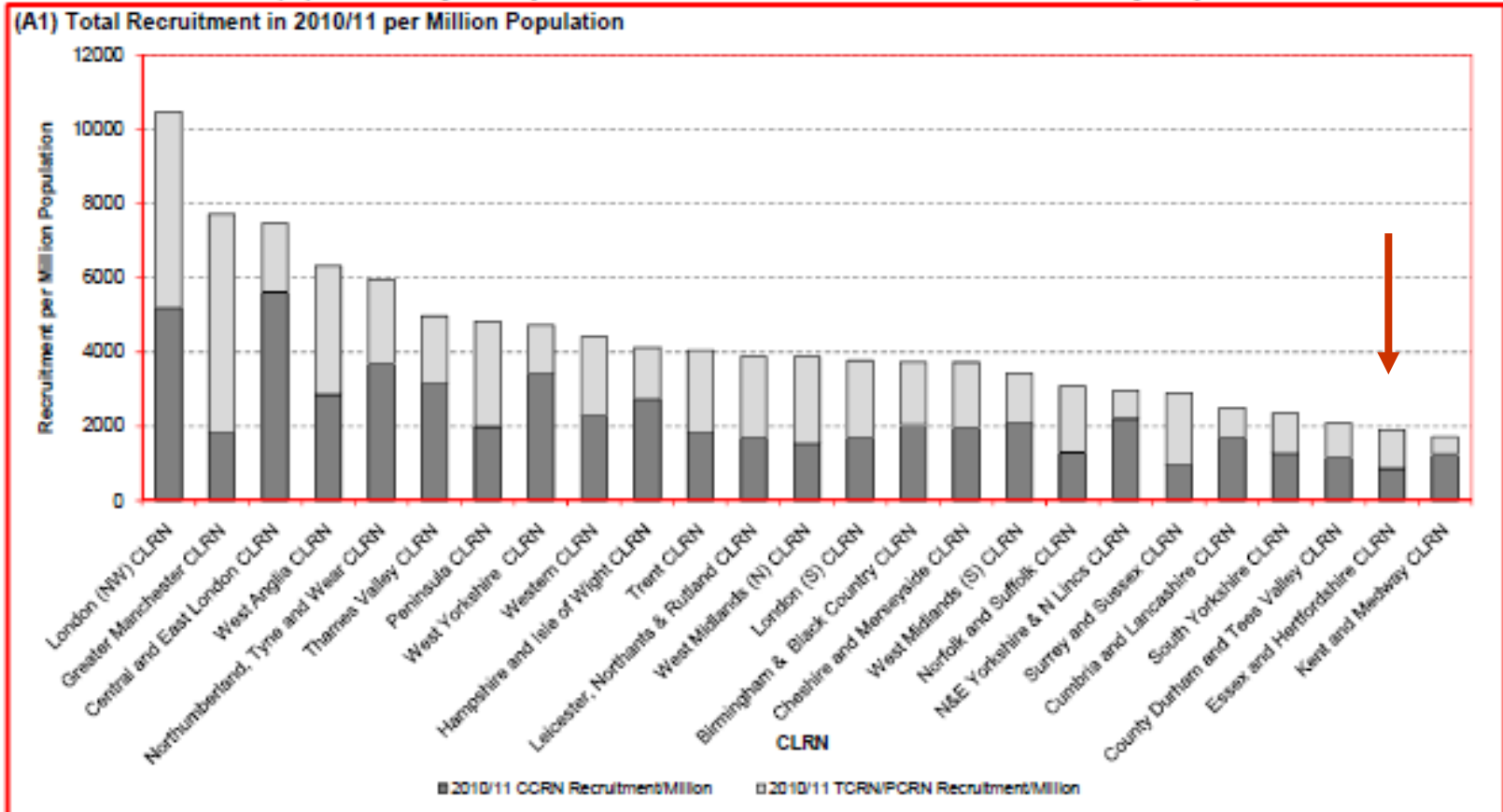

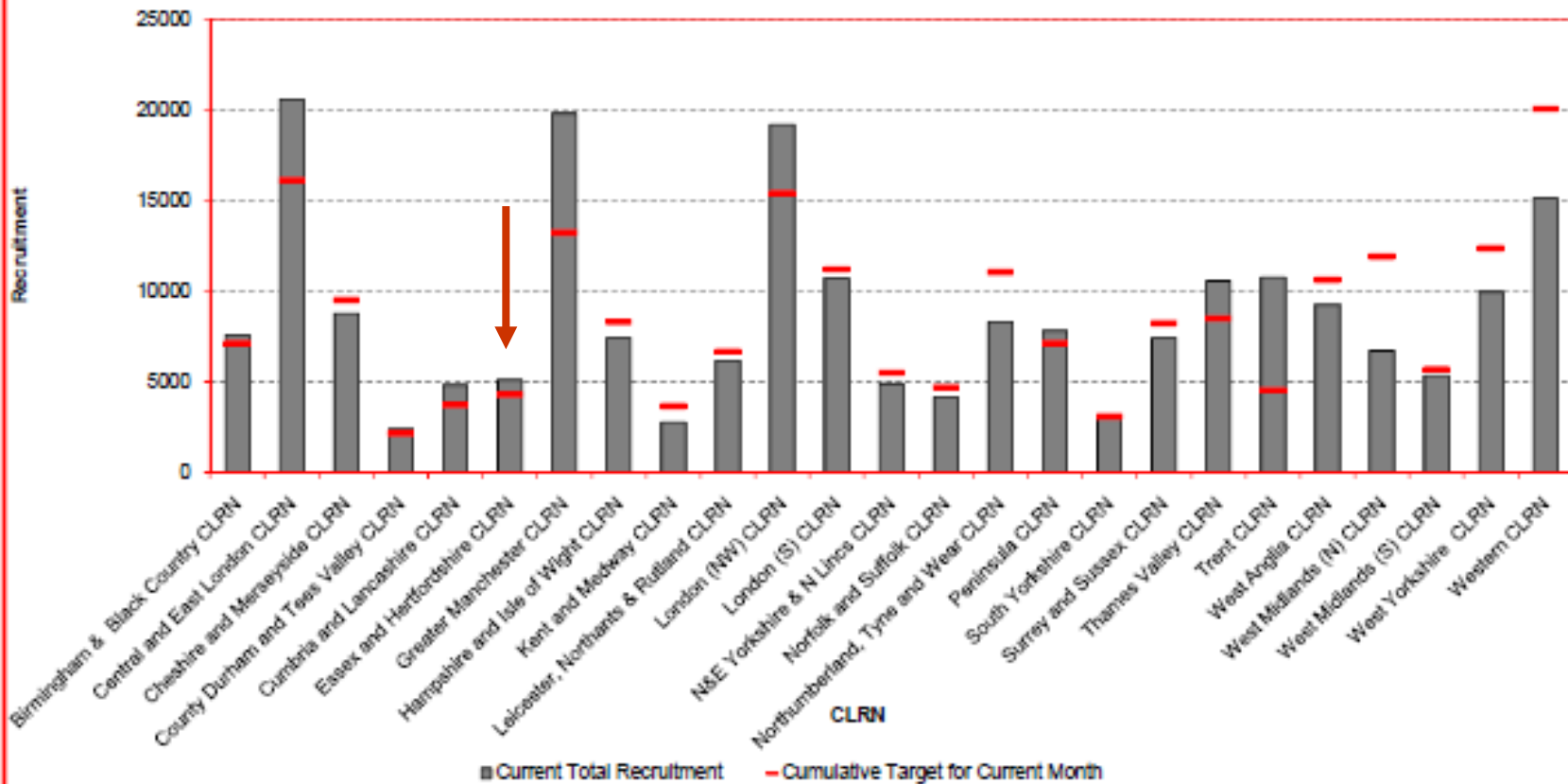
(A) Summary Comprehensive Local Research Network Activity Reports



This figure shows recruitment into topic-led studies (TCRN/PCRN) and comprehensive-led studies (CCRN) in the financial year 2010/11 to date. Recruitment is standardised over the CLRNs by expressing it per million population. That is; total recruitment / (local population / 1,000,000).

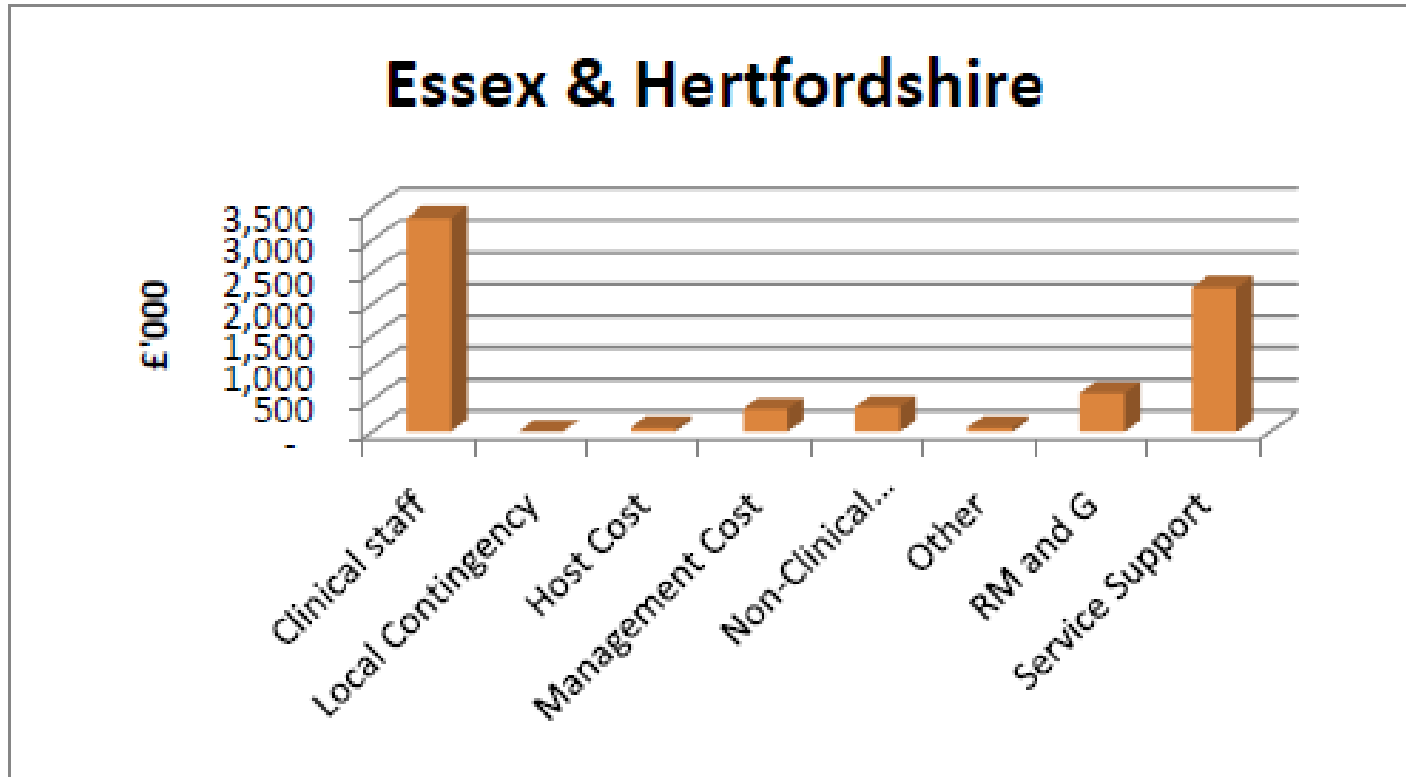
Are we delivering 'Value for Money'?

(A2) Total Recruitment 2010/11 to Date Compared to Targets by CLRN



This figure shows total recruitment in 2010/11 (into all studies). The bars represent the target recruitment which has been agreed by each CLRN as agreed with the member Trusts, for 2010/11 and are derived by taking the annual target, dividing this by 12 and multiplying this by the number of months passed in the current financial year. We currently expect a study to upload recruitment information within 6 weeks of the end of the month in which the participant was recruited. The targets provided on the graph are therefore agreed for 2 months previous to the month in which the report is provided. For example, total recruitment figures in June will be expected to have reached the target for April.

What this translates into?

- **All NHS Trusts** in Essex & Hertfordshire participate in the NIHR Clinical Research Network Research!
- **200+** NHS staff funded by the CLRN
- Median No of days from **SSIF receipt to NHS Permission letter** - **59 days**
- Median No of days from **SSIF receipt to Governance Report** ready for Trusts to check/sign off - **64 days**
- Median No of days from **Governance Report to NHS Permission** - **3 days**
- **63%** of studies recruited to are **Interventional studies** contributing 27% of our total recruitment

'New' studies & research sites (Jan 2011 data)

2008/09

- **182** recruiting unique studies running across 276 sites with the recruitment totalling **6698**

2009/10

- **225** recruiting unique studies running across 204 sites with the recruitment totalling **9049**

2010/11 part-year

- **232** recruiting unique studies running across 124 sites with the recruitment so far **7323**
- **25 'new' sites recording recruitment for the first time**
